

Worcestershire County Council Report
Meeting of Clifton Parish Council 4th November 2021

1. Latest Covid Figures as at 4th November are:
 - a. Worcestershire is showing an infection rate of 448 cases per 100,000.
 - b. The infection rate in the Malvern Hills District is 426 cases per 100,000.
 - c. The direction of travel varies in district within Worcestershire.
 - d. Wychavon has the lowest infection rate in Worcestershire with Wyre Forest District the highest rate at 493 per 100,000.
 - e. The rate of infection in England as a whole is 415 cases per 100,000.

2. The vaccination of children aged 12 and over is now progressing in schools, with Booster jabs being offered to those over 50 and the otherwise vulnerable.
